If you are applying for and will be in receipt of a teachers' service pension or teachers' deferred pension, please complete the section below and return the form to belairdirect to determine your eligibility for the NSTU group insurance plan.

Once belairdirect receives the form below, you will be sent a letter confirming receipt. At the appropriate time, you will receive a confirmation of coverage letter outlining your benefits and premiums. If not currently enrolled in the plan, you will receive information on the benefits you are eligible to apply for.

Please note that application in the NSTU group insurance plan must be made within 60 days of your first pension cheque.
