Re: Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) Notification - CPI -1%

This letter is to inform you that the increase in the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the 12 months ending April 30, 2021 was not greater than 1 per cent. As a result, **effective July 1**, 2021, a COLA (commonly known as indexing) will not be granted to your monthly pension for the next 12-month period.

The average CPI for the 12 months ending April 30, 2021 was 0.88 per cent. COLA may only be granted when the increase in the average CPI is greater than 1 per cent.
