Teachers' Pension Regulations Amended: Maximum Age to contribute – 35 years or Age 71

The Teachers' Pension Plan regulations have been amended to permit a teacher to contribute to the Nova Scotia Teachers' Pension Plan to a maximum of 35 years or until the end of the calendar year in which they attain the maximum age under the Income Tax Act, which ever comes first. The maximum age under ITA is age 71.

This replaces the age 69 rule.
